

## Care and Cleaning Instructions

The health and safety of our customers and communities are of utmost importance to us. The following guidelines have been compiled to help you clean you recycled plastic furniture and also disinfect it to eliminate contagions.

## How to clean your recycled plastic furniture

The durability, hardiness and ease of maintenance are some of the greatest advantages of plastic patio furniture. Not only will it not rot corrode, it is also exceptionally easy to clean.

For surface dust simply hose it down with cold clear water. For generally cleaning, scrub the boards with a soap and water solution using a soft sponge or bristled brush. You can you use a soft-bristle toothbrush to clean hard to reach spaces. Rinse and thoroughly dry the furniture with a towel or wipe down with a clean, soft cloth to avoid water marks.

For stubborn marks on you recycled plastic furniture a magic eraser may be used.

To deep clean, a pressure washer can be used on the lightest setting. It is not recommended to use more than 1500 PSI keeping the tip of the pressure washer at least 10 - 12 inches from the furniture so it does not damage the finish.

## How to disinfect your recycled plastic furniture

Our recycled plastic furniture doesn't harbor contagions, so scrubbing the surface of our product with the following guidelines is all that is required to disinfect it.

To disinfect and protect against viruses lingering on the surface of the lumber, the CDC recommends using a bleach solution of 5 tablespoons (1/3 cup) bleach per gallon of water.

Always wear gloves and eye protection when using bleach and never mix it with anything but water.

Using the bleach solution, scrub the surface of the lumber with a wet, soft cloth or sponge. The surface must remain visibly wet for at least 4 minutes, allowing it to dry on its own.

After 4 minutes, the surface may be rinsed thoroughly and wiped dry to eliminate water marks.

## About these guidelines

Always read and follow the product manufactures' specific instructions before using cleaning product, If using alternative cleanings solutions than those outlines above, it is recommended to test the solution on an inconspicuous area of the lumber to make sure it does not harm the surface.
